Past President's Message



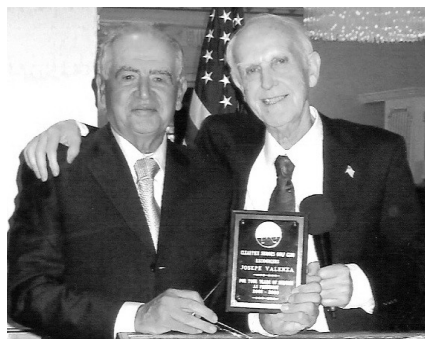
I welcome this opportunity to close out our year end Newsletter in the President's Message column. Now that I am officially a

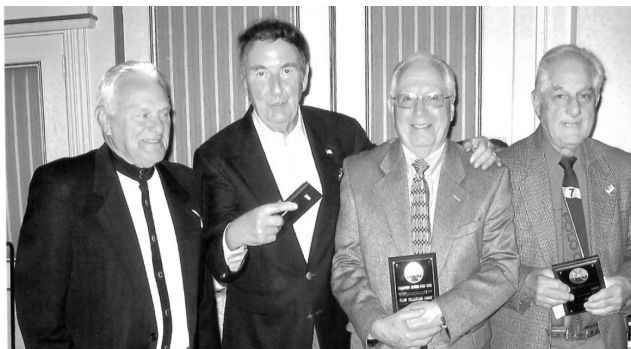

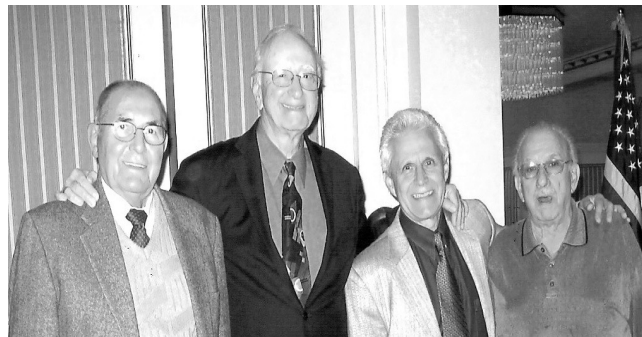

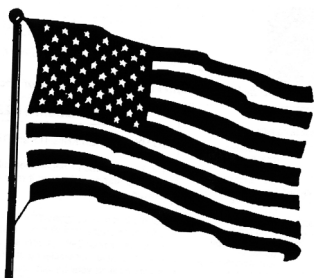
