The fall outing was run by Lou Stovell and his very hard working committee. Weather forced the lunch and awards indoors but it was a special day and will be well remembered.

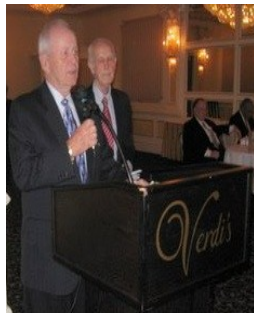
Next year we will start with opening day on April 4, 2012. At this time we have some openings for new members. Contact Frank Savarese or myself for applications

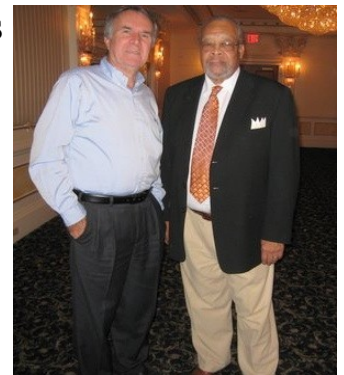
